

Covid-19 Procedures:

Explanation: Due to the rapid spread and precautions given by the CDC and MDH presented by the Governor and following suit with local Day Care Facilities as well as Public School Systems Grindstone Lake Bible Camp asks for compliance for the following pre-camp and post-camp policies.

1. **Pre-Camp:** Please take the temperature one night previous and the morning of for your camper, and all other siblings or relatives that may be coming onto camp property for Check In on Sunday. This will help us ensure that your child and family have no signs of Covid-19.
2. **Pre-Camp:** Please make sure your camper, and anyone who attends check in with you has been fever free and off of medication, like Ibuprofen and Tylenol, for 72+ hours.
3. **Pre-Camp:** if your child has a fever accompanied by coughing, sneezing, and other symptoms please call camp to arrange for a transfer, refund, or voucher for a later week, or for summer 2021
4. **During Camp:** Campers will have their temperature taken through a health screening (lice, medication check in, and temperature) during our check in procedures. This will help us ensure that your child is healthy at that time. We will not be taking any other bystanders temperature that day.
5. **During Camp:** Your camper's temperature will be monitored by suggestion of the MDH and following the same procedure as daycares and public schools. This is because we want to help identify and contain any spread of a communicable disease specifically Covid-19 as temperature is a good indicator of Covid-19. Temperatures will be taken at meal times and high temperatures may be isolated for preventative protocols.
6. **During Camp:** Camper Cabins will be smaller this year allowing for more space between campers. Each camper will have a bunk and will either sleep on top or on the bottom. We will follow proper cleaning procedures daily as has been the practice for many years previous. We will continue to discourage the sharing of hair brushes, tooth brushes, and other personal hygiene items (this includes siblings).
7. **During Camp:** Activities will be outside allowing for more space for large group gatherings.
8. **During Camp:** Electives will have stricter cleaning policies, which may result in use of disinfectants, wipes, and other cleaning chemicals for equipment. **Please make known any allergies to such products during the health screening portion of our check in and on our registration.**
9. **After Camp-** When checking out your camper please take your temperature and the temperature of accompanying children to ensure that we continue to keep your camper safe.
10. **After Camp-** Please monitor and return any pertinent information such as a positive test for a communicable disease like Covid-19, so we can follow our notification policy.

***Overnight camps** are generally less susceptible with the above procedures in place because there is a controlled environment with little interaction with the general public. Following these procedures we can help prevent the spread of communicable diseases.
